### **Team Managers Information**

#### Maccabia Desk

The desk is located in the Daniel Rowing Center boathouse. Any general information and instructions can be obtained at the desk.

#### **Information Center**

The information center is located in the <u>boathouse 1<sup>st</sup> floor (main office of the rowing center)</u>

All the start lists and results list or any other information will be distributed at the welcome desk/information center, and displayed at various locations in the <u>boathouse</u>.

Boats rentals:

The participating teams will be required to pay rental fees for covering the insurance and transportation expenses only: Skiff: 50.00 NIS- per day Doubles 100.00 NIS- per day Fours 200.00 NIS- per day **Payments must be done before the 1<sup>st</sup> training day to the rowing OC** for the whole period of the training and competitions. \*including competition and training days.

### GENERAL PROGRAM

#### **Official Opening of the Regatta Venue**

The Rowing Venue is officially open for training on Wednesday, July 17th, 2013. 6 AM.

#### Training Time Table before the 1<sup>st</sup> racing date

July 17<sup>th</sup>, July 18<sup>th</sup>, July 19<sup>th</sup> the course is open for training from 06:00 AM until 19:00 PM. Teams must be careful in the afternoon as there are public boats too in the same time. Transport to the venue and back is arranged by the Maccabia Transport team.

#### **Training Time Table during Racing Days**

Will be communicated after the final program will be announced.

#### NOTE:

The Jury may warn a crew (Yellow Card) that is training on the course (In the racing day) before the 1<sup>st</sup> race of the day. Such warning is valid for their next race and will have the same effect as one given for a false start.

#### **Racing Time Table**

The provisional Time Table of the races is published at the end of this document. (appendix B)

#### Meetings.

#### **Technical/Team Mangers meeting and the DRAW**

1<sup>st</sup> meeting and the draw will take place on Friday, July 19<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 at the team managers meeting room, Daniel Rowing Center, 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

The team managers meetings on racing days will take place 30 minutes after the start of the last race of the morning and the afternoon at the at the same room as above.

#### **Training and Competition on the COURSE**

The traffic rules for training apply during all the times that the course is open for training. (See appendix C)

The traffic rules for racing shall apply from 30 minutes before the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> race until after the finish of the last race. (See appendix D).

#### NOTE:

The jury may warn a crew (yellow Card) that violates the Traffic Rules during training or warming up. Such warning is valid for their next race and will have the same effect as one given a false start.

#### **START PROCEDURE**

The start procedure will be given by the "FLAG/SOUND" start system. Crews must be at their starting position two minutes before the starting time of their race. Once the roll call begins the crews must make sure their boats are straight. Once the roll call begins the starter shall take no further notice of any crew which than indicates that it is not ready or that it is not straight.

#### **Boat Numbers**

An official of the OC will distribute the boat numbers at the OUT pontoon. An official of the OC will collect the boat numbers at the IN pontoon.

#### Spare Oars/equipment

The spare oars/equipment will be collected near the IN pontoon 40 minutes before the start of the first race every day and transported via a boat to the start. They will be returned back after the finish of the last race each day. Team managers are requested to collect the spare oars/equipment after the last race of every day from the OUT pontoon.

#### **Team Facilities and Services**

#### **Boat Storage**

All boats will be staged in the boathouse or outside under shaded covers. The team managers are responsible to make sure not to change the place of their boats.

#### **Cleanliness on the site**

Garbage Bins are placed on the site in the boating areas for collection of trash. **The use of glass bottles is forbidden in the boathouse area.** 

#### Launch Pontoons

Teams must use the Launch pontoons for going OUT on the water and coming IN as shown in the Traffic rules maps.

#### **Boat Repair**

There will be repair services in the boats area.

#### **Boat Washing**

Boats must be washed after going out from the water. There is a place for washing the boats located in front of the <u>boathouse</u>. After the boats have been washed they must be removed immediately.

#### **Changing Rooms**

The teams' changing facilities are located on the top floor of the boat house building. The showers and toilets are on the same floor.

#### Teams are requested to keep the facilities tidy and clean.

#### **Rest Areas**

There will be two designated rest rooms in the top floor of the <u>boathouse</u>. (Air-conditioned rooms).

#### **Medical Facilities and Services**

#### **First Aid Services**

• During Training and Racing: First aid service will be provided in <u>the boathouse</u>.

## Note: The expenses for any medical treatment are the responsibility of the patient.

#### **Rescue and Safety**

#### • **During Training:**

The rescue service will start operating from Wednesday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. The rescue boat will be patrolling during all the times that the course is officially open for training.

#### • **During Racing:**

Two boats will be stationed along the course and the cooling down area. They will start operating 30 minutes before the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> race of the day until after the finish of the last race.

#### **Doping Control**

There will be on the top floor of the boathouse building a designated room for doping test if it will be necessary.


#### Victory ceremony



## Appendix B Provisional Time Table of the races and progression system for the event.




All crews will be seeded by racing a Head of the River preliminaries, starts evry 15sec., one boat at a time.
